On student self-government “Student council”

Autonomous educational organization «Nazarbayev Intellectual schools»

International School of Nur-Sultan

2020-2021 academic year.

Student self-government called «**Student council**» - is a social student movement of International school of Nur-Sultan (ISN), which unites all the students of the school to do independent actions to realize their initiatives within the school.

Main activities are:

- Creating a positive and supportive environment for students;
- Setting fair and appropriate expectations for the behavior of students;
- Organizing a platform for all students in order to provide feedback, express views and influence decisions in organizing school activities:
- Cooperation with external organizations and organization of students' activities in the direction of "Service and Action";
- Monitoring compliance with school subjects;
- Stimulating the creativity of students;
- Formation of a positive culture;

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Student self-government "Student council" is an independent activity of the school for the implementation of youth initiatives in ISN through students' self-government bodies.

2. Student self-government sets itself the goal of creating conditions for the disclosure of the creative potential and self-realization of each student, attracting him/her to active participation in the life of the school.

3. In its activities self-government is guided by the Constitution of the Republic of Kazakhstan (hereinafter RK), the law of the RK "On education", standard rules on the activities of the school community "Shanyrak" in the branches of the autonomous organization of education "Nazarbayev Intellectual Schools", the internal regulations of ISN and the regulations on the branch "International School of Nur-Sultan" of the autonomous educational organization "Nazarbayev Intellectual Schools".

4. Student self- government is realized through the activities of members of student council and other school students. Ученическое самоуправление реализуется через деятельность членов ученического самоуправления и учащихся школы.

5. Students that study at ISN can be elected to be the part of the students' council.

2. GOALS, OBJECTIVES AND PRINCIPLES OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF STUDENT SELF-GOVERNMENT

1. The main goal of the development of the "Student Council" is to ensure a positive and supportive environment and personal growth of each students of the school as an educated, holistic person with high educational competence, capable of creativity fulfilling his/her human and social destiny.

2. The development of "Student Council" at ISN is aimed at:

Cooperation with external organizations and the creation of the necessary conditions conducive to the active involvement of students in the implementation of the component of the International Baccalaureate (hereinafter IB) "Service and Action" and social activity through the assistance of the administration and educational structures of the school;

- strengthening the role of the school community "Shanyrak" in the upbringing of students, education in the spirit of tolerance and intercultural thinking, asserting the lifestyle at school within the framework of the IB component "Service and Action", mutual exactingness, a sense of social justice, a healthy moral and psychological climate, approval based on wide publicity moral principles;

- Assistance to the student in the development of creative potential, inclinations, abilities, life self-determination, self-realization in life, school, environment, future profession.
- 3. Principles for the development of student self- government :
 - Interaction of student governing bodies “Student Council” with the administration, in combination with a clear delineation of functions of student government bodies “Student Council”. Every self- government body solves its specific tasks, at the same time there are general issues when it is advisable and necessary to interact, unite and coordinate efforts, which should not affect the independence of student self- government bodies “Student Council”.
 - Functioning of student self- government bodies “Student Council” based on the involvement of the entire school community (students, parents, teachers, administration) in solving school issues on the basis of free and open expression of will;
 - Integration of extracurricular educational work, educational process and research activities;
 - Selectiveness, openness, publicity, consistency, collegiality.

3. SUBJECTS OF STUDENT SELF-GOVERNMENT

1. The subjects of self-government are the school communities “Shanyrak”.
2. The supreme body of student self- government in ISN is the “Student Council”, which has the right to consider issues of the life of the school, organization and development of student self- government .
3. Student council meets once a week.
4. Student council at ISN:
 - On a quarterly basis hears reports from the Leaders of the Student council on the implementation of the goals and objectives of the student self- government ;
 - Determines the main directors of activities of the school community “Shanyrak”.

2. All decisions of the Student council are recorded, formalized by the decision of the leaders of the Student council, and communicated to the students of the school.
5. «Student council» in ISN represents the interests of all students in school and outside the given educational institution at various levels: city, regional, republican and regional.
6. The main functions and activities of the Student council:
 - Increasing the prestige of education among students;
 - Improving and creating a positive and supportive environment for learners;
 - Coordination of the school community “Shanyrak” at school, forecasting and designing the main directions of student activities of students;
 - Continuous monitoring of the state and development of various areas of student life at school;
 - Recruiting and training members of the Student council “Shanyrak” school community.
7. Members of «Student council»:
 - Leaders of «Student council»;
 - Coordinators «Student council»;
 - Other students, grades 4-5 students of primary and grades 7-11 of high school based on the decision of the Student council.

4. POWERS OF THE LEADERS OF THE «Student council»

1. Leaders of the self- government «Student council»:
 - Cooperates with external organizations, and organization of student activities in the direction of “Service and Action” in order to develop the component of the IB.

- Organize the work of the school community “Shanyrak”, preparation and holding of student council meetings;
- Share experience with other school;
- Represent the interests of the Student council in relations with the school administration and monitor compliance with school policies and student protection rights;
- Control the implementation of the decisions of the Student Council;
- Appoint responsible persons for various areas of student activity in the school;
- Report on their activities at the meetings of the Student council;
- Issue orders within their competence;

5. PROCEDURE FOR ACCEPTANCE, CHANGES AND ADDITIONS OF THIS REGULATION

1. Proposals on amendments and additions to these regulations are sent to the Student Council to its leaders and then discussed. Then the leaders of the Student Council may decide to meet again to discuss the regulations.
2. All proposed changes and additions must be included in the protocol.
3. The regulations apply to ISN students.
